Approach:

The Alabama Forestry Commission, in partnership with the Alabama Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries Division, will restore 950 acres of longleaf pine on Barbour Wildlife Management Area (BWMA). These acres will be restored to longleaf pine using ARRA and other funds.

Objective:

To partner and execute longleaf restoration projects on Barbour Wildlife Management Area.

Expected Results:

- Restore approximately **950 acres** on BWMA planting containerized longleaf

Target Date for Achievement:

Target date to accomplish this project is March 1, 2011.

- **50** acres of skidder herbicide application
- **337.3** acres of container longleaf planted
- **166,667** containerized longleaf seedlings planted; total of **2.33** jobs retained
- Projects covered two (2) counties: Barbour and Bullock
